2010 KENTUCKY CHAPTER STATE CONFERENCE Session Overview

AM Sessions

811- Call Before You Dig
Session will cover the importance of calling 811 Before You Dig as well as the responsibility of the contractor after the call.

Urban Landscaping
Session will address facets of urban landscaping (correct plants, trees, etc.) as well as a city or county's first impression to motorists as they enter the local jurisdiction.

PM Sessions

Confined Space Entry
Session provides an overview of entry into a confined space, when should entry be permitted, and how to complete the necessary paper work.

MUTCD Update
The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, or MUTCD, defines the standards used by road managers nationwide to install and maintain traffic control devices on all public streets, highways, bikeways, and private roads open to public traffic. On December 16, 2009, a final rule adopting the 2009 Edition of the MUTCD was published in the Federal Register. States must adopt the 2009 National MUTCD as their legal state standard for traffic control devices within two years.

Special Course Offering

Work Zone Traffic Control Flagging Course
This course is intended for individuals who perform flagging and temporary traffic control activities on Kentucky's roadways. This training session includes lectures, videos, and hands-on exercises to

present the following: proper use of personal protective equipment, work zone components and types of operations; flagging procedures, proper and improper flagging operations, as well as communicating with workers and the public. Individuals performing flagging operations on any Kentucky roadway must be qualified and certified by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet every two years.
